Bible Class Notes – From John's Gospel – Lesson 45A The Lord Jesus Christ is Eternal God.

This week our lesson considers The Jesus Christ as Eternal God – I AM THAT I AM.

During life He is the **first** we should go to with our sin, troubles, and trials, for He is the only one Who can help us. If we are His then He has promised to never leave us of forsake us. **(Hebrews 13v5)**. Let us begin with Jesus Christ, staying close to Him so that we will end our life on earth with Him; that He will be with us in death so that we can spend eternity in Heaven with Him. Let us know the power of His resurrection and look to Him with joy and expectancy; glorifying Him as our **Alpha and Omega** from day to day.

The Eternal Existence of God – 'I AM that I AM'.

- The Lord Jesus Christ is Eternal God 'I AM that I AM'. To Be, To Exist.
- o This is why the Lord Jesus Christ spoke so many times as being, 'I AM'
- Always, eternal, no beginning, no end. Consistently the same holy, merciful.
 'I AM Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last'. (Rev 22v13)
- The Lord Jesus Christ is God The Creator of All Things. Genesis 1 v1, John 1 v1
- In the beginning God (אֱלֹהִים, 'elôhîym, Elohim more than 2). Father, Son, Holy Spirit.
 'For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word (the Son), and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one'. (1 John 5v7)
- The Lord God spoke to Moses at the Burning Bush.
- o Tell Pharaoh, 'I AM THAT I AM hath sent you'. (Exodus 3), 'Let My People Go'.
- o Almighty God sent the 10 plagues on Egypt as judgement for rejecting Him.
- The Lord God Gave His Commandments.
- o The Lord God declared to Moses, 'I AM the Lord your God'. (Exodus 20 v2)
- o The first 3 Commandments present God as Unique, Holy, Just, and Merciful.
- The Lord God Confirms Christ's Deity God The Son.
- o 'This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased'. (Matthew 3v17, & 17v5)
- Christ Confirms His Deity To The Unbelieving Pharisees.
- . He said, 'Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I AM'. (John 8v58)
- o Their response Hatred They took up stones to cast at Him. (John 8 v59)
- o **But Jesus,** (using His Almighty power), hid Himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by. (John 8 v59)
- Christ Demonstrated:
- His Deity in the Garden of Gethsemane:
- His enemies came to arrest Him As soon then as He had said unto them,
 'I AM He', they went backward, and fell to the ground. (John 18 v6)
- Yet He freely gave up Himself to them. His time had come to face the cross.
- His Ability To Save All Who Come To Him in Repentance and Faith:
- Oh! What love! He willingly died on Calvary to save lost sinners like us.
- 'It is finished' He had completed His substitutionary sacrifice by taking the wrath of God for our sin if we will repent and believe on Him as Saviour.
- His Absolute Power Over Sin and Death:
- He Rose again from the Dead I AM The Resurrection and The Life. (John 11v25)
- He Ascended into Heaven and will return again one day as Judge.

The Angel's message, 'Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into heaven'.
