Bible Class Notes - From John's Gospel- Lesson 46

The 'I AM' Sayings of the Lord Jesus Christ.

This week we continue lessons which teach the almighty saving power of Jesus Christ.

"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain" to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing". Revelation 5v12

Important Lesson for us Today:

When we know the truth it will set us free (John 8 v32). God has revealed His Truth to us in the Bible. We need to be teachable and prayerfully seek the help of The Holy Spirit to reveal this Truth to us. There is a danger that we will be tempted to misconstrue what God has made clear in order to satisfy our own thinking. Rev 22 v18,19 warns us not to do this. We must use Scripture to interpret Scripture to be sure of a correct understanding. The Lord Jesus Christ must be the centre of our belief. Some have rejected Him altogether, others have replaced Him by the 'Church', some deny that Christ is Eternally God, whilst others reject the need of turning from this world in repentance of sin and faith in Christ's death and shed blood for sinners on the Cross of Calvary.

Revision - The I AM's of The Lord Jesus Christ

• Jesus said I AM:

- 1. The Living Water Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst. (John 4 v14). Just as we need water to live, our souls need Christ as Saviour, The Spiritual Water of Life Eternal.
- 2. The Bread of Life He who comes to Me shall not hunger. (John 6 v35).
- 3. The Light of The World He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 8 v12).
- 4. The Good Shepherd All who came before Me are thieves and robbers (John 10 v8); The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. (v11)
- **5. The Door** Christ died to save. Only forgiven sinners can enter Heaven.
- 6. The Resurrection of Life He who believes in Me shall live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die. (John 11v25-26)
- 7. The Way, The Truth, and The Life No one comes to the Father, but by Me. (John 14 v6). The Lord Jesus Christ is the ONLY Way to The Father.
- 8. The True Vine Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He (The Father) takes away; and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes it, that it may bear more fruit. (John 15 v2). We grow in Sanctification – more like Christ.

• John The Baptist said that Jesus was:

- 9. The Lamb of God Who takes away the sin of the world. (John 1 v29).
- 10. The Son of God That believing you may have life in His Name. (John 20 v31)

Points 1 to 9 above are Amazing Claims - They Prove the 10^{th.}

- The whole point of God The Son, The Lord Jesus Christ, leaving Heaven to come to earth as a Perfect Man to die as a substitute, taking on Himself the wrath of God for our sin, was to give us spiritual life – now and into Eternity.
- He rose again, victorious over sin, death, the grave and Hell, and has ascended into Heaven to intercede for us. He is The Resurrection and The Life.
- The Lord calls us to personally repent and believe that He did all this for us.
- Do we hunger and thirst after righteousness? Do we recognise The Light?
- Do we see ourselves as lost sheep needing a Shepherd to save and guide us?
- How sad it would be, knowing His Names and why He came, IF we refuse to respond to His gracious call to come to Him in repentance and faith? We would miss out on all these wonderful blessings, provisions and gifts.

The Apostle John wrote about the Lord Jesus Christ, "But these (things) are written, that ve might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ve might have life through His name". John 20 v31
