# "What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?" Mark 4v41

Important Lesson for us today: People may ask the question, "Is there anything too hard, or too difficult, for the Lord God to do?" We must answer, emphatically, "NO", because, He is, after all, Sovereign, Almighty God who is Omnipotent - All **Powerful.** In the beginning God created all things from nothing by the Word of His Power. He also continues to sustain everything by the Word of His Power. All events are under His Sovereign will. He has total Power over life and death. Remember, He rose from the dead, providing eternal salvation for all His People. Therefore, we can trust the Lord without doubt, or fear, to save us from our sin.

### The Lord Jesus Demonstrates His Power Over Nature.

- Our Journey Through This Life.
  - We set out Inexperienced, Vulnerable yet convinced we can manage on our own without the Lord's Protecting Guidance.
- Beware There are Many Dangers Ahead of Us.
  - **Life is Unpredictable** we never know what will happen next.
  - The **Unexpected** 'storms of life' cause fear, and alarm taking away our peace, and happiness. In who or what do we trust?
  - We are Frail and Weak There is only one heart-beat between us and death, which will take us to meet our God.
- The Lord Jesus Christ, As He is God is All Powerful Omnipotent:
  - o He, The Creator God, was in control even whilst He was asleep!
  - He, Our Creator God, can save us even though He is in Heaven!
  - o As Their Saviour God, He said "Peace, be still" the wind and raging waves stopped immediately. Now they were all safe.
  - o As Our Savour God, He has Power to calm and bring peace to the 'storm' of sin and fear in our lives, if we believe on Him.
- The Sovereign Lord Tests the Sincerity of our Faith and Trust in Him.
  - o The experienced fishermen panicked in the storm while He slept. They committed the sin of unbelief, thinking their lives were in danger – surely, a problem too great for the Lord to handle.
  - o If we trust the Lord as our Saviour, and as our Sovereign God, then we must trust Him to care for us, no matter what happens in life.
- How Should We Respond To The Challenges of Life's Events?
  - O Do not commit the Sin of Unbelief. Do not doubt, nor think that anything is too difficult for the Lord. Remember Who He is.
  - Trust that this same Saviour, Who spoke to calm the stormy sea, has the Power to save all who call upon Him, and that He will care for them throughout their life, and into eternity.
  - **Obey Him** Just as the wind and waves **obeyed** their Creator.
  - Pray 'Lord, Please, forgive me, I believe, help Thou my unbelief'.
