Day	Bible Reading	Tick When Read
Sunday	Mark 5v21-34 (Jairus came in faith seeking the Lord's help)	
Monday	Mark 5v35-43 ("Jairus, be not afraid, only believe")	
Tuesday	John 11v1-20 (Lazarus had been dead 4 days)	
Wednesday	John 11v21-46 ("Lazarus, come forth", He came forth)	
Thursday	Luke 24v1-12 (The empty tomb – Christ is risen)	
Friday	Luke 24v13-35 (The risen Lord appears to His disciples)	
Saturday	Luke 24v36-53 (Christ opened the disciples minds)	

Important Lesson for us today: *The resurrection is not a story – this really happened. Do not take the amazing power of the Saviour over death for granted. Remember – He gave His life on the cross and He took it back again, proving that He is The Almighty Son of God. The only One that we must trust for salvation and eternal life. If we doubt Christ's resurrection, or refuse to believe it, then His death and resurrection has no benefit for us. We will have no hope of forgiveness and that eternal place in Heaven that He has secured for, and promised to, all who will repent and believe in His death and resurrection.*

EDT Bible/College Class Take Home Sheet.

This sheet is given to remind you of the lesson and to encourage you to read your Bible.

The Lord Jesus Demonstrates His Power Over Death.

- **How did Jairus, a Ruler of the Synagogue, approach The Lord?**
 - **He put aside his importance.** He came, humbly, believing, and knelt.
 - **He came in desperation** – He Knew only Jesus could save his daughter.
 - **He was persistent** – He waited patiently, in faith, and did not give up.
 - **He trusted** – He believed that Jesus would heal his sick daughter.

We also must come to the Lord in the same way – Humbly, patiently, honestly, sincerely seeking forgiveness; using God's gift of faith; believing that the Lord Jesus Christ will hear and answer our heartfelt and faithful prayer of repentance.

- **We notice from the Bible narrative: -**
 - **Jairus' great need** – His daughter was very ill, near to death. Mark 5v21-43
 - **Jesus delayed**, stopping on the way to heal another. **Why did He do this? As Sovereign God, Jesus knew Jairus' daughter would die.** He also knew that, as He has power over death, He could restore her to life again.
 - **Jesus kindly said to Jairus, 'Be not afraid, only believe'.** Mark 5v36
 - **At Jairus' home** - mourners scoffed at Jesus, but Jairus believed.
 - **Jesus miraculously restored Jairus' daughter back to life.**
- **What does this miracle of The Lord Jesus Christ teach us?**
 - **As The Saviour who gave His life** on the cross of Calvary, and then rose again by taking it back again, He has complete power over death.
 - **He is interested in us**, and gave His life to save sinners like us.
 - **We are dead in our sins** – needing a Saviour to give us spiritual life.
 - **Jesus can give new life immediately** – If you are truly earnest then find somewhere quiet and ask Him, believing in faith, to forgive you your sins.
 - **Conversion must involve our complete trust and belief in the Eternal, Triune, Creator God - The Almighty and All-Powerful Saviour.**
 - **Repentance must involve** hatred of our sin and a resolve to turn from it.
 - **There is Life after Death** – The Lord has promised Eternal Life for every true believer, so, **'Be not afraid, only believe'** in the Lord's power to save.

We also notice the love and compassion of the Lord Jesus Christ. He loves with an everlasting love and shows this love by giving His life on the cross that we sinners can be saved from the guilt of our sin. **John 3v16, Hebrews 12v2**

The Apostle Paul wrote, "Therefore, we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life". Romans 6v4
