## In The Beginning, God Created All Things

This week we learn from Genesis - God Created All Things by The Word of His Power

# For by Him (The Lord Jesus Christ) were all things created, that are in Heaven, and that are in the Earth, visible and invisible. Colossians 1v16

### The Lord God Demonstrates His Power In Creation.

- In The Beginning God! He was already there. Always has existed.
- The LORD God is Eternal No beginning, no end, always there. John1v1
- **The Never Changing Triune God** Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- $\circ$  The Lord Jesus Christ is called The Word, The Creator. John 1v1-3.
- The Omnipotent God All Powerful He speaks, it happens.
- As Creator God, He spoke, Genesis 1v1. "Let there be" thus creating all things in an instance, from nothing, by the Word of His Power.
- Unbelievers say, 'There is No God, so things just happened by chance'.
  God asks Job, and us, "Where were you when I created the Universe and set all things in order, and in their place?" See Job 38v4
- God chose to create all things in six literal, 24 hour days.
- **His Power Instantaneous,** no need for millions of years of evolution.
- God established the rules and laws of nature, sustains them, and even has the power to override them, (this is called a miracle).
- This week we consider the First Two Days of Creation.
  - Day 1 Day and Night, Light and Darkness, The start of Time.
- **Originally Light from God** God is Light, brighter than the noonday sun.
  - Note: The Sun was not created until Day 4.
- Time, 24-hour day, came into existence Day and Night. Genesis 1v5, Hebrew 'Yom'. 24-Hour Day. Used throughout the Old Testament.
- Day 2 The Heavens (Space, Universe, and Sky), and The Earth.
- Created from nothing kept in their place by God until He set the orbital rules in place for the Solar System on Day 4. Genesis 1v14-19.
- We can fully trust and believe the Bible account of Creation.
- We should be amazed at all the complex detail that must be in place for things to exist. This could not happen by chance! It needs a designer.
- $\circ$  ~ If we will not believe it then we accuse God of being a liar. 1 John 2v4,22.
- We should also believe that God has sent His Son, The Lord Jesus Christ, to die on the cross to take the punishment for our sin. John 3v16
- God, the Maker, and Sustainer of The Universe wants us to look to Him in repentance and faith, and ask Him to be our Saviour, and LORD. Believe Him, Trust Him today.

The Apostle Paul wrote, "For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse." Romans 1 v20.
