Sunday	Genesis 8v1-12 (God saves Noah and his family)	
Monday	Genesis 8v13-29 (Noah worships God for saving him)	
Tuesday	Genesis 9v1-17 (The Rainbow – God's promise)	
Wednesday	Romans 1v1-6,17-32 (Paul notes the sinfulness of man)	
Thursday	Psalms 113 (Who is to be compared with the LORD?)	
Friday	Psalms 115 (Give glory unto the Name of our God)	
Saturday	Psalms 121 (The Lord is the preserver of the soul)

This sheet is given to remind you of the lesson and to encourage you to read your Bible.

See The Almighty Power of God in Creation and Salvation.

The Lord Jesus, as God The Son, and Creator of All Things, Demonstrated His Almighty Power: -

- **Over Nature.**
 - He commanded the winds and waves to obey Him by the Word of His Power – He can keep us safe through all the ‘storms of life’.
- **Over Death – Physical and Spiritual.**
 - He raised Jairus’ daughter back to life - He can give us Eternal Life.
- **Over The Devil – The Enemy of Our Souls.**
 - He restored the wild man of Gadara to his right mind - He will provide protection for us from the enemy of our souls and give us victory over, Satan.
- **Over Need.**
 - He fed 5,000 men (plus women and children), with 5 loaves and 2 fish – As The ‘Bread of Life’ He feeds our Souls with Spiritual food, His Truth – to know Him, to obediently follow Him, to praise Him, and to witness to others.
- **Over Illness.**
 - He restored Blind Bartimaeus’ sight – He can ‘open’ our eyes to see Who He really is – Our Creator God and the Saviour of our souls.
- **In The Creation of Everything by The Word of His Power.**
 - He Created man in His own image with a Living Soul – To Know Him, Walk with Him, Obey Him, Live for Him, and Enjoy Him for ever.
- **In Judgement of The Wicked – All Who Reject God's Way.**
 - Adam & Eve were Judged – Death - Physical and Spiritual. Thankfully the SEED was promised. A perfect Man Who would come one day to die to save repentant sinners. The Son of God, the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - Cain rejected God's Way – Rejected by God – No place in Eternal Heaven.
 - In Noah's Day - The Universal Flood, The Ark to Save, The Rainbow Promise.
 - A Solemn Warning of The Final Judgement by Fire - yet to come.
- **In The Salvation of Lost Sinners by His Death on Calvary.**
 - The Lord Jesus Died, taking the Punishment for Sin on Himself – that we might repent, receive forgiveness, and be saved from The Final Judgement.
 - He Rose again, Ascended to Heaven and will return as The Righteous Judge. We can only stand in that Day if our sins are forgiven through faith in Christ.
