The 10 Commandments – God's Moral Law, His Rules for <u>all</u> time.

God's 5th Commandment – Obey all who rule over us.

- Relevant to all of us regardless of age, gender or our status.
- In order to be at peace with God, useful to Him, and a blessing to others, we need to be teachable, humble, ready to listen, believe and to obey.
 Christ is our example in this. Seek, and find Him as your Saviour and Lord.
 Then, with His help and guidance, seek to live a sanctified life, as He did.
- We form good or bad habits from those who have authority over us.
 Seek to cultivate good habits, and learn from the mistakes of others.
- God wants to lead and guide us as we grow up, and later, as adults.
 Learn right from wrong, and live to be a good example to others.

God promises a reward to all who keep this commandment.

- Individuals, Our Family, Church, School, Work, and Society as a whole will see the fruit of the Spirit in us - love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance (self-control).
- o These characteristics will flourish for our benefit, and for all those around us.

Who must we respect and obey? The 5th Commandment includes: -

- 1. Father and Mother, Guardians.
- o 'Children, obey your parents, in the Lord'. Ephesians 6v1
- o Show honour (obedient respect), love, and gratitude to parents.
- o Parents are responsible to bring up their children God's way. Ephesians 6v4

2. Godly and Faithful Teachers.

- Act upon that which Bible believing Pastors and Teachers teach us. Hebrews 13v7
- o Let the Bible be your sole rule and guide, reading it daily, with prayer.

3. Lawful Authorities.

- o Keep the common law of our country where it agrees with God's law.
- o "Be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates". Titus 3v1.
- 4. Ultimately, we must obey The LORD God, our Creator.
 - o Jesus Christ said, 'If ye love Me, keep My commandments'. John 14v14
 - o **Never say**, 'I will not obey, I will do whatever I like'.

Wise Solomon wrote, under the inspiration of God, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep His commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil". Ecclesiastes 12v12,13
