God's Adoption, and Sanctification to fit us for this life, and for Eternal Heaven

Important Lesson for us today: As 'children of Adam' we are not naturally in God's Family. God has predestinated (chosen) the believer in eternity past (Ephesians 1v4,5); not for any good He saw in them, but out of His pure love and mercy. Those He has predestinated He gives faith to repent and believe, having Adopted them into His family through His wonderful Electing Love. Christ died to save His chosen ones and, by doing so, makes them immediately perfect (Justified – just as if they had never sinned), fitted to be called His sons and daughters, clothing them in His righteousness. He also causes believers to grow, over time, in Sanctification (set apart from the world, to become more like The Lord Jesus Christ). Justification is immediate, Sanctification is progressive.

- Tower of Strength Protection from both physical, and spiritual enemies, and troubles in this sinful world.
 Adoption is achieved by God the Father having not spared His own Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, from death on the cross. Romans 8v32.
- **Provides for every need** Both physical (e.g. a home, food, clothes, safety, security, love), and spiritual (e.g. eternal safety, and forgiveness, a family on earth the Church, and Heaven as our eternal home).
- Hands down His skills He teaches us through the Bible how we should live and gives us the help of the Holy Spirit to live to His Glory.
- **Trains and improves us** Influences our characters, discernment, and principles through **Sanctification**. Christ being our example.
- Provides for our future Passing on an eternal, and incorruptible inheritance, 1 Peter 1v4; making us Heirs of God, Joint Heirs with Christ. Romans 8v17.

We have learnt: -

We are Fallen and Lost in sin, Called by God to Repent and Believe, Justified by Christ's death on the Cross, and now Adopted into God's family, to grow like the Lord Jesus Christ in Sanctification. How wonderful our God is!
