Important Lesson for us Today: Sin bars everyone from Heaven. Everyone thought the Scribes and Pharisees as being very righteous, pleasing to God; yet the Lord exposed them as sinners. Are we guilty of their sin or of other sins? Their sin: Prejudice - Their minds were made up - Jesus was not God. Proud - They felt so much better than everyone else, acceptable to God. Hatred - They looked for faults in the Lord to bring Him down. Hypocrisy - They tried to appear religious but broke God's rules. Dishonesty - They used religion to gain wealth and status. What a blessing that God's mercy and love at Calvary's Cross has made a way for us to enter Heaven - forgiven and made perfect!

## The Way Into Heaven Made Possible by Christ's Death

- The Temple a Visual Aid to Help Our Understanding.
- All God-fearing Jews could enter the outer courts of the Temple,
   BUT only the High Priest, once a year on the Day of Atonement,
   was allowed into the Holy of Holies, after a ceremonial cleansing.
   A picture showing us of our need of the Lord Jesus Christ Who can present us righteous to our Holy God, earning Heaven for us, if we believe in Him.
- A veil/curtain acted as a barrier of entry and protection to keep the Holy of Holies holy! Showing that our sin bars us from entering Heaven.
- Why is Sin Barred from Heaven?
- Heaven must be protected: God is holy and pure, and He must protect Heaven. Just as a drop of poison contaminates pure water, one drop of sin would completely ruin Heaven, and so it cannot be allowed in.
- To protect sinners! No one can see God and live. Just as extreme heat destroys unhealthy bacteria, so the holiness of God destroys all sin.
   An unforgiven sinner entering God's presence would instantly perish.
- Why a Veil and not a Brick Wall as a Barrier?
- God's use of a passable, temporary barrier, a veil, shows us that He has a Sovereign plan that will successfully overcome our problem of sin.
- How can the Barrier of Sin be Removed?
  - When was the veil torn in two and the Holy of Holies made accessible?
     It was when the Lord Jesus Christ voluntarily and gladly died upon the cross and took the punishment of all the sins of every one of His People.
- Why was the veil torn from the TOP to the BOTTOM? God alone could pay the price of the sins of His People and give them the righteousness (holiness) that they need to enter His Holy, Eternal, Kingdom of Heaven.
- The Only Way to Heaven The Lord Jesus Christ. John 14v6
- The only way to be certain of Heaven is to realise that all our hope of entering depends on the Lord Jesus Christ and what He did at Calvary.
   We must recognise His amazing love and our own unworthiness and ask Him to forgive us. Then we will know that He is our God and Friend.
