# The 'I AM' Sayings of the Lord Jesus Christ.

**This week** we continue lessons which teach the almighty saving power of Jesus Christ.

Jesus said, "I AM the Bread of Life ...
If any man eat of this bread,
he shall live for ever".
John 6vs 48 and 51.

Important Lesson for us Today: Our physical bodies will one day die but our spiritual souls will live forever - either eternally safe with God in Heaven or miserably in Hell. What makes up our Soul? What is the essential Us? It is: -

Our **Conscience**: the part that tells us what is right or wrong. **God's law written in us.**Our **Mind**: where we think, reason, understand and plan; not by instinct as animals do.
Our **Will**: the part that determines to do something even if it goes against our conscience.
Our **Heart**: the part of us that drives our will to action and makes us desire something.

If our soul is fed and driven by a love and devotion for the Lord Jesus Christ this makes us safe now and forever. Our eternal safety is only when we are 'in Christ' and living for Him.

## Jesus Christ Said, 'I AM The Bread of Life'

- The Crowd, over 5,000 strong, saw only their Physical Needs.
- o They wanted healing from their diseases and to be miraculously fed.
- Selfishly they wanted to be entertained, enjoying the excitement and surprise of what spectacular miracle the Lord would do next.
- o They wanted a King who would set them free from Roman rule.
- They refused to hear they had a spiritual need; they were sinners who needed forgiveness, but their pride was offended by this message.

Does the message of the need to recognise our sin and seek forgiveness offend?

- The Lord, in compassion, fulfilled their Physical and Spiritual needs.
  - As Creator God, He miraculously fed all of them using a boys' lunch.
- Yet, Jesus also taught that souls are more important than bodies, desperately needing spiritual forgiveness and healing from Him.
- Jesus said, 'He that believeth on Me hath everlasting life, I AM The Bread of Life'. Have faith, 'eat' of Me and you shall live eternally.
- We need both Physical and Spiritual Bread:
  - o Bread is essential for life Christ is essential for our soul's life.
- O Without food we die without Christ's salvation we are dead to God.
- o Bread is a staple food the Lord must come before anything else.
- We need it daily we need to pray to God and read His Word daily.
- o It builds strength trusting in Christ strengthens our character.
- o It provides energy the Lord energises our obedience and witness.
- o It suits all diets Christ is for all ages, backgrounds, and cultures.
- But Looking and Knowing is not enough We must Believe and Obey.
- o Looking at bread will not stop our hunger we need to eat it.
- Knowing that there is a God is not enough we need to believe that the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ, offered Himself on the cross, in our place, to take the punishment of Hell that our sin rightly deserves.
- He takes our guilt and gives us His righteousness. What a Saviour!
   Do we believe this? A personal faith in Jesus Christ is essential.
   Remember, God hates our sin but loves us even though we are sinners!
