The 'I AM' Sayings of the Lord Jesus Christ.

This week we continue lessons which teach the almighty saving power of Jesus Christ.

"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing". Revelation 5v12.

Important Lesson for us Today:

When we know the truth, it will set us free. John 8v32. God has revealed His Truth to us in the Bible. We need to be teachable and prayerfully ask the help of The Holy Spirit to reveal this Truth to us. There is a danger that we will be tempted to misconstrue what God has made clear to satisfy our own thinking. **Rev 22v18,19** warns us not to do this. We must use Scripture to interpret Scripture to be sure of a correct understanding. The Lord Jesus Christ must be the centre of our belief. Some have rejected Him altogether, others have replaced Him by the 'Church', some deny that Christ is Eternally God; others reject the need of turning from this world in repentance of sin, not putting faith in Christ's death when He shed His precious blood for sinners on the Cross of Calvary. Is He your Saviour?

Revision - The I AM's of The Lord Jesus Christ.

- Jesus said I AM: -
- 1. The Living Water Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst. John 4v14. Just as we need water to live physically, our souls need Jesus Christ as Saviour, The Spiritual Water of Life Eternal.
- 2. The Bread of Life He who comes to Me shall not spiritually hunger. John 6v35.
- 3. The Light of The World He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness but shall have the Light of Life. John 8v12. Light gives knowledge of the Truth.
- 4. The Good Shepherd All who came before Me are thieves and robbers, John 10v8; The Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep. John 8v11.
- 5. The Resurrection of Life He who believes in Me shall live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die. John 11v25-26.
- 6. The Way, The Truth, and The Life No one comes to the Father, but by Me. John 14v6. The Lord Jesus Christ is Truly the ONLY Way to The Father.
- 7. The True Vine Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He (The Father) takes away; and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes it, that it may bear more fruit. John 15v2. We must grow daily in Sanctification more like Christ.
- John The Baptist said that Jesus was: -
- 8. The Lamb of God Who takes away the sin of the world. John 1v29.
- 9. The Son of God Believe this that you may have life in His Name. John 20v31.
- Points 1 to 8 above are Amazing Claims They Prove the 9^{th.}
- The whole point of God The Son, The Lord Jesus Christ, leaving Heaven to come to earth as a Perfect Man to die as a substitute, taking on Himself the wrath of God for our sin, was to give us spiritual life – now and into Eternity.
- He rose again, victorious over sin, death, the grave and Hell, and has ascended into Heaven to intercede for us. He is The Resurrection and The Life.
- $\circ~$ The Lord calls us to personally repent and believe that He did all this for us.
- $\circ~$ Do we hunger and thirst after righteousness? Do we recognise The Light?
- Do we see ourselves as lost sheep needing a Shepherd to save and guide us?

How sad it would be, knowing His Names and why He came, IF we refuse to respond to His gracious call to come to Him in sincere repentance and faith? We would miss out on all His wonderful blessings, promises, provisions, and gifts; the most precious being forgiven the guilt of our sin and being given His righteousness to fit us for eternal life with Him in Heaven. Is your sin forgiven?

The Apostle John wrote about the Lord Jesus Christ, "But these (words) are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through His name". John 20v31.
