Lessons From People Who Followed Jesus

This week – continuing our series of lessons which teach us how to savingly follow Jesus Christ.

Jesus said, "Suffer (allow) little children to come unto Me, and forbid them not: for such is the Kingdom of God." Luke 18v16.

Important Question for us Today: Are you waiting before you come to Christ? No doubt you have heard God's gracious Gospel call many times. In Lesson 61 we considered those who responded, 'Yes, I will follow, BUT later, I have more important things to do right now'. Some 'follow', attending church, BUT insist on living a worldly life. These responses are very sad and fraught with the danger of our souls being eternally lost. The Lord says, 'Those who have a serious determination to follow Me will come humbly as a little child, fully trusting Me as their Saviour and Lord, and show respect to God The Father as their loving Heavenly Father'. They will not want to be half-hearted, giving a false testimony, but will have a God given desire to follow Jesus Christ as their pattern for life.

If we have repented, let us imitate the Lord - always acting from holy principles, adhering strictly to truth, for God is the God of truth. Let us imitate our God, for He commands us to do so, our relationship to Him requires it, and be rewarded with peace in our souls. **Read Philippians 4v7,8.**

• The Lord's View Of Children – Different To That Of Most People.

- Many look down on children, pushing them away, even despising them.
- \circ $\,$ The Disciples turned the children away 'Jesus has more important things to do.'
- But The Lord said, 'Allow them to come, forbid them not, they are important.'

Six Essential Bible Truths For Us To Carefully Consider:

- God Created Us As Human Beings, Spiritual, With Eternal Souls.
- As our Creator He commands that we should worship Him, love Him, trust Him, and live lives of obedience to please Him. This is reasonable for all ages.
- We Must Repent Because We Have Sinned against Our Holy God.
- God has given us a conscience an awareness of right and wrong fairness.
- God 'speaks' to our conscience through our reading His Word, and our hearing faithful Gospel Preaching. 'Hear ye Him', Matthew 17v5.
- We Must Place Our Trust In The Lord God To Forgive Us.
- Only the Lord Jesus Christ (Perfect God and Perfect Man), by dying on the cross in our place, can take away the guilt of our sin. Only God can forgive us.
- 'But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us'. Romans 5v8.
- We Must Be Converted The Wonderful Work of God The Holy Spirit.
- He humbles us to accept that we are sinners and have broken His Holy Law.
- When God converts us, He gives us faith to believe what The Bible teaches us about Him, renewing the desire of our heart to love Him and to hate our sin.
- We Must Return The Lord's Love Through Obedience To Him.
- When we realise the great love of God that sent His Son to Calvary to suffer and die to save us, then we will love Him and serve Him - with willing hearts.
 'For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life'. John 3v16.
- We Must Take The Highway To Heaven The Narrow Road.
 - \circ $\,$ Seeing this world as empty and vain we will live our life to please The Lord.
- We cannot be a true Christian if we continue to mix our lives with enjoyment of the ways of this evil world. **Read Psalm 1. "Blessed is the upright man."**
- Conclusion Do Not Wait Any Longer Come To Jesus Christ Now.
