Read Matthew 22v35-40, and the Bible passages referenced below.

The 10 Commandments, The Law of God.

Foundational for all of Scripture.

The revelation of God's good pleasure, the foundation of the Gospel, and the standard for the Christian's Obedient Walk.

- I. THE LAW: THE REVELATION OF GOD'S GOOD PLEASURE.
 - A. The Lord Jesus Christ's Assessment of the Law: Foundational to the Entire Body of Revealed Truth.
 - 1. The Living Word, Jesus Christ: -
 - gave the Law verbally at Mt. Sinai. Act 7:38.
 - inscribed with His own finger in tables of stone.
 - 2. The entire body of revealed truth flows out of the Law! Matthew 22:37-40.
 - B. The Law in its Original Form: -
 - 1. This law was written upon Adam's heart. Rom 2:15.
 - 2. The Law as given at Mt. Sinai: 8 x "Thou shalt not..."
 - C. The Law: God Reveals the Purpose of Man's Creation.
 - 1. Man: Created a relational being by a relational God.
 - 2. Man: Created with unique faculties to know, love, and obediently serve His Creator. Romans 7:25.
 - 3. Man's sacred obligation: To respond in love to God's revelation of love—toward Him & men.
 - D. The Two Tables of the Law Focus on God The Son.
 - 1. The 1st table's requirement: To love God as He has revealed Himself in His Son. John 1:18. John 3:16.
 - 2. The 2nd table's requirement: To love our neighbour, created in the image of God's Son. Mark 12:30-31.
 - 3. Obedience to the Law: Rendering supreme honour to the Son of God's love. John 5:23, Peter 1:17.
 - E. The Law: The Eternal Standard of Moral Conduct.
 - 1. The eternal transcript of the mind of an Eternal God—who loves His Son! Mark 1:11, Peter 1:17.
 - 2. God's holiness: His utter and infinite devotion to the glory and honor of His Son. Psalm 89:35.
 - 3. The Law: The eternal norm of conduct for the redeemed—to honour God's Son by honouring His Law.

- II. THE LAW: THE FOUNDATION OF THE GOSPEL.
 - A. Fallen Man: Required to obey God's Law Perfectly
 - B. Sinful man, as a Law-breaker, James 2:10.
 - 1. Inclined to hate God and his neighbour.
 - 2. Our transgression of the Law provokes God to infinite wrath. Ezekiel 18:20. Galatians 3:10.
 - C. An Offended Lawgiver Provides forgiveness for Law-breakers!
 - 1. The Ceremonial Law: God's *gracious* revelation of His Law—a schoolmaster to Christ. Gal. 3:24.
 - D. The Wonder of the Incarnation—the Word Made Flesh.
 - 1. The Lawgiver is the Law Keeper—the Holy One! Psalm 40:7-8.
 - 2. The Lawgiver willingly becomes the Substitute for Lawbreakers.
 - Willingly permitting Himself to be treated as a Lawbreaker. 2 Cor 5:21. Gal 3:13.
 - 3. On the cross: The Lawgiver secures redemption (forgiveness) for Lawbreakers. Col. 1:20.
 - E. The Gospel: Good News for Lawbreakers!
 - 1. Christ has obeyed the Law perfectly Rom 3:31. and has paid the penalty of the Law exhaustively, and has silenced the curse of the Law eternally.
- III. THE STANDARD FOR THE CHRISTIAN'S WALK
 - A. The Blessed Fruit of the Cross: 1 Corinthians 1:30.
 - 1. Justification: Complete pardon of Lawbreakers.
 - 2. Sanctification: Transformed into Lawkeepers.
 Sinners who come to Christ & become like Christ!
 - B. Obedience to the Law: The Believer's Expression of Love for their Savior
 - 1. Christ's emphasis on the connection between loving Him and obeying Him. John 14:15,21,23.
 - 2. Honouring His written Word honours Christ, The Living Word. Mat 7:21 1 John 5.
 - 3. Answer to the purpose for which we were created.
 - C. The Confession of the Genuine Believer: "Oh, How Love I Thy Law!" 1 John 2:3-5, Psalm 119:97.
