- 1. God is the True Source of all Happiness. VA**
Spiritual happiness brings peace
and joy to our soul. Galatians 5vs22,23. VA

- 2. Worldly Happiness: - VA**
God gives Happiness to all.

To enjoy good music, art, literature, experiences, etc.

The World offers many sinful experiences.

Satan, our enemy, wants us to indulge.

To spoil our happiness.

Bringing short term happiness which soon turns into regret, sadness and disappointment.

Eventually eternal regret. Away from God.

The unbeliever looks in the wrong place for joy, VA

peace, and satisfaction.

Challenge – Do we try to enjoy worldly, sinful, happiness?

- 3. We note that there are 2 kinds of God.**
 - a. False gods and false religions.**
Man made, Some even based on Christianity,
 - b. There is only ONE True God.**
The God of the Bible.
He is One God in 3 Persons.
Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
He is eternal and immutable.
He is Sovereign in Creation, Providence,
and in Redemption.

Nothing happens outside of
His Sovereign or Permissive will.

- 4. Joy of The Godhead: - VA**
The Father – Isaiah 53v10

On the cross the Saviour took our place
under His Father's holy wrath.
John 3v16, *"For God so loved the world,*
that He gave His only begotten Son."

The Son – *"For the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame."*
Hebrews 12v2.
